The December meeting of the Bull Run Region was held on December 13, 2020 at the Manassas VFW Hall. Past President Pete Pandolfi volunteered to conduct the meeting given our Vice President was out sick. Ten members were in attendance therefore no actions were taken. The following topics were discussed.

1. Pledge of Allegiance
2. Treasurer's report
3. Nicki Hudson reported that the Installation Banquet is scheduled for January 10 at the City Tavern in Manassas. The Governor's increased COVID-19 restrictions do not affect the event. What's In a Name

This is a new feature I am introducing for this year. I have always been fascinated with automotive logos and badges. This article will present a badge or logo and provide a brief explanation of the item. My primary source for this information is "Car Marques: A Graphic Guide to Automotive Logos and Emblems" by Simon Heptinstall and published by Quintet Publishing.

Alfa Romeo is an Italian car manufacturer with a deep



history in automobile racing. Founded in 1910 in Milan, Italy, Alfa is actually an acronym for Anonima Lombarda Fabbrica Automobili, which translates to the Lombardi Automobile Manufacture Corporation. Romeo is the last name of the founder Nicola Romeo.

The badge features a red cross on a white background which is the ancient symbol for Milan on the left side and a man-eating serpent which is from the coat of arms of Visconti family who ruled Milan in the Middle Ages. This badge continues to be used to this day on its cars and even on its Formula One racing cars.

December Meeting Presentation

“Selected Short Subjects”, a collection of short auto-related films, took the place of a scheduled speaker at the December Bull Run meeting.

Twelve movies were shown. The oldest was an interrupted "take", shot from the front of a cable car proceeding down San Francisco's Market Street in 1906 -- just days before an earthquake and fire re-



duced the city to ruins. Horses, horseless carriages, pedestrians and cable cars contended with one another for room on the avenue. The newest movie, from 2011, was a brief vignette of Margaret Dunning, a 101-year-old resident of Plymouth, Michigan, and the 1930 Packard Straight Eight roadster which she drove regularly.

As in any traditional movie palace, the presentation contained a feature, newsreels and an animated cartoon as well.

The feature film (a full eight minutes long!) was "The Other Fellow", a 1937 Chevrolet promotional film starring character actor Edgar Kennedy. It demonstrated, in a humorous way, that road rage dates back to long before the 2000's.

Of the newsreels, two from 1928 chronicled the then-new phenomenon of antique car collecting. In one, a hapless enthusiast is unable to drive his vintage curved-dash Olds more than a few feet before it dies.





December Presentation continued

In the other, members of an old-car group stage a race with their ancient relics, to the great amusement of crowds lining a street in Long Island. From 1932 came a newsreel clip of a remarkable new invention in which cars could be parked on gondolas strung together on a vertical, multi-story belt. (Though it's now a common thing, this was terribly cutting-edge at the time.) Another newsreel segment featured the "Dynasphere", a gigantic rolling tire in which passengers rode on a suspended cradle.



A 1948 short feature presented three futuristic streamlined car prototypes, none of which ever reached production: the Davis 3-wheeler, the TASCO by Cord designer Gordon Buehrig, and an unnamed car with a teardrop design.

The cartoon was "Susie The Little Blue Coupe", a Disney production from 1952, which follows the life of a car from its debut in a showroom window to its retirement to a junkyard, and its subsequent rebirth.

Also included were two 'traffic studies' -- one from 1928 and the other taken about ten years later: unedited, "raw" film clips from Oregon and California that recorded in real-time the automotive bedlam that often occurs at street intersections.

A quiet musical interlude, filmed in the 1940's, combined a front-seat view of a driving excursion up New York's East River Drive with Tommy Dorsey's version of "Manhattan Serenade", presumably playing on the car's radio.

The show included a short intermission during which freshly-made popcorn was supplied to the audience.

The entire sequence of movies was projected directly off the Internet (using pre-selected links). Those clickable links are available to any Bull Run member curious to see the films, by e-mailing Jon Battle at detailed@verizon.net.


